Accutane, Amnesteem, Claravis, Sotret	Isotretinoin	Pill	Should NOT wax without Doctor's note.
Armour	Thyroid hormone	Pill	Should NOT wax without Doctor's note.
Protopic	Tacrolimus	Cream	Should NOT wax without Doctor's note.
Efudex	Fluorouracil	Injection	Should NOT wax without Doctor's note.
Retin-A, Renova, Atralin	Tretinoin	Cream	Client should NOT use within 7 day period before and 7 days period after waxing. SHOULD reschedule appointment to comply with this schedule.
Differin	Adapalene	Cream	Client should NOT use within 7 day period before and 7 days period after waxing. SHOULD reschedule appointment to comply with this schedule.
Epiduo	Adapalene/ Benzoyl Peroxide	Cream	Client should NOT use within 7 day period before and 7 days period after waxing. SHOULD reschedule appointment to comply with this schedule.
Duac, Benzaclin	Benzoyl Peroxide/ Clindamycin	Cream	Client should NOT use within 7 day period before and 7 days period after waxing. SHOULD reschedule appointment to comply with this schedule.
Ziana	Clindamycin / Tretinoin	Cream	Client should NOT use within 7 day period before and 7 days period after waxing. SHOULD reschedule appointment to comply with this schedule.



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Acanya	Clindamycin/ Benzoyl Peroxide	Cream	Client should NOT use within 7 day period before and 7 days period after waxing. SHOULD reschedule appointment to comply with this schedule.
Benzac, Panoxyl 5/10	Benzoyl Peroxide	Cream	Client should NOT use within 7 day period before and 7 days period after waxing. SHOULD reschedule appointment to comply with this schedule.
Azelex, Finacea	Azelaic Acid	Cream	Client should NOT use within 7 day period before and 7 days period after waxing. SHOULD reschedule appointment to comply with this schedule.
Aczone	Dapsone	Cream	Client should NOT use within 7 day period before and 7 days period after waxing. SHOULD reschedule appointment to comply with this schedule.
Eldoquin, Epiquin, Lustra, Melanex	Hydroquinone	Cream	Client should NOT use within 7 day period before and 7 days period after waxing. SHOULD reschedule appointment to comply with this schedule.
Solodyn, Myrac, Dynacin, Minocin	Minocycline	Antibiotic	SHOULD advise client that waxing may cause skin sensitivity before performing services.
Doric, Vibramycin, Monodox, Adoxa	Doxycycline	Antibiotic	SHOULD advise client that waxing may cause skin sensitivity before performing services.
Cleeravue-M, Tetracon, Declomycin	Tetracycline	Antibiotic	SHOULD advise client that waxing may cause skin sensitivity before performing services.



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Erygel, Benzamycin, Erythrocin	Erythromycin	Antibiotic	SHOULD advise client that waxing may cause skin sensitivity before performing services.
Cleocin T, Clinda-Derm, Evoclin	Clindamycin	Antibiotic	SHOULD advise client that waxing may cause skin sensitivity before performing services.

Additional Notes:

Over the counter skincare products: Products are generally safe with waxing.

NOTE: If client is using exfoliating products, advise the client that waxing may cause skin sensitivity before performing services. Client may need to stop product use a few days before and after they are waxing the service is performed.

Botox in Chemical Peels: client she'll wait at least two weeks after treatments to receive waxing services.

Radiation Therapy: SHOULD advise client to consult with his or her doctor before performing services. Should NOT wax with out Doctor's note.

Other Medications or Treatments: SHOULD advise client to consult with his or her doctor before performing services. SHOULD advise client who choose to receive waxing services to make Waxter aware of any discomfort during the service.
